Rules for admission in M.Pharm I year, 2010

1. Candidate in the final year of above degree examination can also apply on provisional basis. But at the time of counseling, such candidate shall have to produce the original certificate of having passed/mark sheet of the final year of the degree examination.
2. There shall be separate merit list for each category like SC, ST, OBC and General etc.
3. Admitted candidate if wishes to leave the course after last date of admission he has to pay fee for all four semesters before getting transfer certificate even though he had not attended any classes. However in special circumstances Vice Chancellor may take necessary action.
4. Candidates applying under Sponsored category must have minimum two year of professional experience in the subject. (Teaching in Pharmacy institutions, Manufacturing of Pharmaceutical, Medical Sales, Retail Shop, Hospital Pharmacist etc.)
Candidates having experience of more than 2 years shall be given weitage for each extra year. The merit list of such candidates shall be on basis of their B.Pharm. theory marks (25%), additional experience and their performance in personal interview (25 Marks)
5. All other rules shall be applicable as per practice of Barkatullah University which are not covered in present note.

Entrance Examination –

6. Candidates are required to report themselves personally at the given date, time and venue, for the written examination. Non-appearance in the written examination, for whatsoever reason, shall automatically disqualify the candidature for admission.
 - (i) At the time of written examination, candidates are required to bring following original documents, along with two Xeroxed copies of each;
 - (a) Mark-sheet of qualifying examination.
 - (b) Caste & domicile, certificates (for candidates belonging to Scheduled Cast (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Other Backward Class excluding creamy layer (OBC), of Madhya Pradesh).
 - (c) Two recent passport size photographs.
 - (d) In case, any university awards grade in qualifying examination, then Xeroxed copy of certificate from the competent authority of the university, stating equivalent percentage of marks as well as conversion formula used, must be attached along with application form, and the original of the same should be submitted at the time of interview.
 - (ii) Entrance test, personal interview shall be conducted. Marks distribution & pattern shall be

- (iii) Personal interview

Constitution of committee by Hon. Vice-Chancellor
- (iv) B.Pharm. Marks - out of 25
Total % marks obtain in 4 years (I to VIII semesters) in University exam (each theory paper of 70 marks excluding practical & sessional marks) to be converted out of 25.
- (v) Merit list of selected candidates to be prepared on the basis of aggregate marks obtained (v) + (vi) + (vii) out of total 100 marks.
- (vi) All applicants shall be allowed to write entrance test..
- (vii) Entrance test of 60 min. duration, and max. marks 50, shall be conducted.

7. Cancellation of Admission:

If at any stage, it is found that a candidate has got admission in any course on the basis of false or incorrect information or by hiding relevant facts or if at any time after admission it is found that the admission was given to the candidate due to some mistake or oversight, the admission granted to such a candidate, shall liable to be cancelled forthwith, without any notice at any time during the course of his/her studies, by the Registrar of the university.

8. Modification to rules/procedures:

The Barkatullah University Bhopal reserves the right to amend any provision/rules/procedure for admission, to ensure fair and transparent admission procedure or in public interest, without any prior notice. The modifications so made, shall be binding to all.

8.1 If any question arises relating to the interpretation of above rules & procedure, the decision of the University Authorities shall be final and binding.

8.2 The decision of university authorities shall also be final & binding in the matter relating to admission.

9. Refund of fee:

If a candidate gets his/her admission cancelled from the university or admission of an ineligible candidate is cancelled by the university, prior to 7 days before the last date of admission, as declared by the University, the tuition fee and other fee deposited by the candidate in the intuitions shall be refunded back to the candidate by the concerned institution after deducting 10% from the deposited amount.
